### Categories

- A. Baby Quilts (smaller than 240" perimeter)
- B. Bed Quilts (larger than 240" perimeter)
- C. Wallhanging (smaller than 240" perimeter)
- D. Combined Effort (any quilt made by two people – this includes quilts quilted by others whether by hand or machine)
- E. Quilts for All Seasons – Theme Quilt
- F. Group Quilt (any technique, three or more people)
- G. Whole cloth
- H. Youth (quilter is 18 years and under)
- I. Hand quilted – any size (made entirely by one person)
- J. Wearables/Accessories (must be quilted)
- K. Other (Entry does not fit into any other category  
Examples: crazy, yoyo, wool, redwork)

Categories A, B, C, and D will be divided into the following techniques:

1. Appliqué
2. Pieced
3. Mixed
4. Other

### Rules

- \* **Please read all of the rules.**
- \* A non-refundable fee of \$6.00 per entry. Please make checks payable to United Quilt Guild. Send entry forms with payment to: Kim Williams, 12253 Lisbon Road, Salem, OH 44460
- \* Entry forms and fee must be postmarked by Saturday, May 30, 2009. No Exceptions.
- \* Entries must be available for judging and display from June 25 - June 27, 2009.
- \* **You must make a photocopy of this completed form to be presented before your quilt will be released at the end of the show. No exceptions.**
- \* Use one form per entry (copy form as needed).
- \* Entries will be accepted in person at Sebring High School in Sebring, Ohio on Wednesday, June 24, 2009 from 10:00am to 2:00pm.
- \* If quilts are mailed to the show, it is the responsibility of the entrant to make sure sufficient packaging and postage (including insurance costs) is provided for its safe return.
- \* Mailed quilts must be received before Saturday, June 20, 2009, and must be mailed to: United Quilt Guild, Attn: Kim Williams, 12253 Lisbon Road, Salem, OH 44460
- \* All items must have your name & address securely attached to the back of the quilt or inside of the garment.
- \* Quilts entered into previous United Quilt Guild shows will not be accepted.
- \* Torn, soiled or incomplete quilts will not be accepted.
- \* All entries must consist of three layers (two layers of cloth with batting material between the layers), and must be quilted either by hand or machine, with the exception of Category K.

The judges and show committees reserve the right to divide or combine categories, or move entries to more appropriate categories. Written evaluations will be returned to the entrants. Ribbon awards will be given at the discretion of the judges. All decisions of the judges are final.

**Security will be provided.**

Entries will be insured effective upon receipt and for the duration of the show. United Quilt Guild, Inc. will insure quilts while in their possession: \$500 for bed size quilts, and no more than \$100 each for all other entries. Additional insurance is the responsibility of the entrant.

I wish to place an entry in the 2009 United Quilt Guild Show and agree to the rules set forth in the quilt show registration form. I understand that every precaution will be taken to protect my entry, but I also understand that the United Quilt Guild and the 2009 quilt show staff will not be held responsible for loss or damage to the entries exhibited during the show.
